The financial and monetary crisis that has shaken the West and the economic crisis that has been escalating and deepening every day made it even more inevitable collapse of the capitalist economy. The old world reeling under the storm, the volcanoes of anger popular one after the other are erupting one after the other and fall wreaths. Over all the earth imperialism can not find a "quiet oasis". The victory of the Great Proletarian Cultural Revolution has shattered the dream of imperialism and revisionism of the restoration of capitalism in China, and opened in the history of the international communist movement, a bright road designed to consolidate the dictatorship of the proletariat and to lead the way the socialist revolution. The rapid decline of

American imperialism clearly shows that the capitalist system is already in the grip of a new general crisis, a crisis extremely deep. It is engaged in the expansion of armaments and war preparations, supports all existing worst in the world, fascism and bourgeois oppression, he commits aggression anywhere and everywhere install military bases. Within the United States, who claim to be the country's "rich" in the world, tens of millions of people increasingly living in poverty and suffering from hunger, and with the enormous military expenditures decided by the state fatten increasingly large profiteers of the war. The atrocities of fascist Nixon lit the burning flames of the revolutionary mass movement; chaos reigns in the country and most comprehensive in the world Nixon is increasingly isolated.

In the different countries a wind spreads the spirit of the French red May, and the toiling masses generalize their rebellion against big business and against the reactionary governments deployed in defense of the exploitation and engaged in an ongoing police repression. The Soviet revisionist renegade clique, the centre of modern revisionism, always starts up more quickly towards total bankruptcy. To Brezhnev and his associates things go from bad to worse and the situation is getting worse year by year; they are troubled by internal and external crises. Within the country they are continuing in the reconstruction of capitalism and exercise a dictatorship that does not even have the mask of bourgeois democracy; abroad they apply the theory of "limited sovereignty", a form of neo-colonialism and succumb to aggression and expansion. For this reason, in countries dominated by modern revisionism heroic mass rebellions and popular criticism against the regime have reappear. This has completely revealed the nature of the social-Soviet revisionism and has attracted more and more strong opposition both among the Soviet people than among people of various countries. The appearance of Soviet revisionist social-imperialism is only an episode in the process that sees imperialism move towards total collapse. It may not save the entire imperialist system from destruction, nor save itself from ruin. The people and the people alone are the motive force that creates world history.

Through the great upheavals, major divisions and major groups of the sixties, the revolutionary forces of the world have swollen and the deployment of class has become clear. The new development of the fundamental contradictions of the world will inevitably continue to spark the revolution. The seventies are the years when the storm of the popular revolution will break out all over the world with more violence. Chairman Mao has recently pointed out: "People of the world unite to fight any war of aggression launched by any social-imperialism or, in particular a war of aggression conducted with atomic bombs as weapons! If such a war will break out, the people around the world will have to remove the war of aggression with the Revolutionary War, the preparation has to be done about it right now!

“Imperialism means war. The peoples of the world must increase their revolutionary vigilance! American imperialism seems to be a giant, but it really is a paper tiger! After all, in today's world, who's afraid of who? It is not the peoples of Vietnam, Cambodia, Palestine, other Arab countries and the rest of the world who are afraid of American imperialism, but it is American imperialism that is afraid of the peoples of the world. The danger of a new world war still exists, and the peoples of the world must be prepared. But today the main trend in the world is the revolution! The revolution spread and peoples advance. It is close to the dawn of the new world without imperialism, without capitalism and the system of exploitation.

Forward against the big capitalists and the government of Christian Democrats – DC- and their minions.

During the decade of the sixties, the great Italian imperialist bourgeoisie has earned its "place in the sun" in the imperialist world market, so it could participate in the work of international robbery carried out by a handful of imperialist nations to the detriment of the vast majority of 'humanity. A dozen kings of high finance, which dominate Italy, with the help of the government of the center-left, was able to concentrate in their hands an immense wealth, so as to compete with the unbridled wealth of their cronies in the United States and other capitalist countries.

The rapid monopolization and the great mass of capital accumulated in the hands of the Lambs and Pirelli are the product of an operation carried out to the detriment of the whole nation. To focus their financial power, the big capitalists forced into unemployment and poverty a large part of the country's population, have plundered and subjugated most of the small-scale production, forced to work gruelling conditions of millions of workers, reduced to the most black social disintegration the majority of the Italian provinces, have ruined a great mass of peasants and extended their power in all spheres of society. Each social services sector has been kept in complete backwardness, and the whole progress of production, subject to the principle of exploitation, leaving crumbs of privilege and wealth to restricted layers of management elements, bribing them in mass and subordinating them to the great capital, while the social factor was general regression.

The vast process of monopolization and financial phenomenon has resulted in an equal concentration of power in the political superstructure and the state of the country. The unchallenged power of the Lambs and Pirelli allows them absolute control of the state apparatus, now totally subservient to the rich families and far from the people so that the parties and the bodies of bourgeois democracy have become distinctly reactionary and appear more and more as the court of parasites and servants of the monarchy finance.

The Christian Democrats, a direct emanation of the power centres formed with the Second World War, created to represent the United States, the Vatican and the agrarian bloc of fascist south, and the great capitalists of the North, it was found resized in the early sixties to the firm will of the Lambs and Pirelli to liquidate the excessive influence of the bourgeoisie behind. The centre-left was born for this, to bring the reformists in the government, to dazzle the petty bourgeoisie with abstract reforms and obtain from it the support necessary to big capital for its concentration. The bourgeois parties of the left were at the game, dreaming of the great achievements realized under the leadership of big capital, are engaged in the political demobilization of the masses and tried to merge them with big capital and the regime because of illusory economic concessions. The result is clear to all: the great capital has proved first enemy of the workers and, ultimately, always a friend of the backward and reactionary bourgeoisie, the USA and the Vatican. Agrarians, mobsters, and all sorts of fascist reactionaries have put the role of reformists and have helped big business to suppress the mass movement, to plunder the South, to penetrate the power of monopoly everywhere. The speculation and corruption instead of being eradicated have widened dramatically, sectors socialists and republicans are passed to the fascist reaction. The Christian Democratic

Party has reorganized and emerged as the dominant force, the reformists and revisionists had to genuflect to stay further in the "positions" conquered. All political forces and traditional union have been corrupted in the common interests of the reactionary speculation and corruption. Together with the headlong development of the financial and economic crisis of the capitalist world, the situation of the Italian economy has become more precarious. The monopolies have done the impossible in order to intensify the exploitation of workers and the economic difficulties so lean on them.

Of course, the attack launched by the economic policy of the reactionary ruling circles against the workers met with strong opposition among the masses. With growing political consciousness the Italian people have clearly understood that in order to change the situation in which he lives, must necessarily topple the capitalist system. The struggle of the Italian people against the reactionary rule of the monopoly bourgeoisie has reached a new peak in recent years. In all Italian workers, labourers and students went on strike and demonstrated, committing a heroic struggle against the government and its reactionary policy. The storm of a vigorous mass revolutionary movement has invested the entire Italian peninsula. The critical mass against the exploitation of big business and against the reactionary regime has spread with momentum, uniting millions of workers on new and advanced combat positions.

The controversy and the struggle against modern revisionism led by the Marxist-Leninists and the entire revolutionary movement under the leadership of Mao Tse-tung and with the stimulus and the example of the Chinese comrades and Albanians and Marxist-Leninists of the world, has enabled us to achieve new and favourable conditions for the mass movement and the proletarian revolution. The struggle against revisionism and the spread of Marxism-Leninism-Mao Tse-tung, have given rise to a process of increasing unification of the advanced workers and revolutionary intellectuals for the building of the revolutionary party of the working class, the Communist Party Marxist-Leninist of the Union of Communists is the core promoter.

In front of the strengthening of the revolutionary vanguard, and the face of growing mass movement, the bourgeoisie responded with repression and murder of communists and workers. The reactionaries have always thought they could intimidate the people and stifle resistance with bullets and imprisonment. But the facts have shown the opposite: the more reactionary resort to bloody repression, the more you develop the revolutionary forces. The modern revisionists Italian followers of the Soviet revisionist clique, have spared no efforts to defend the "law and order" of monopolies and to hamper a rebellion of the masses. But, to their detriment, the Communists Marxist-Leninist reinforce becoming a living body and present all over the country, and the mass movement, like the raging waves of the sea, broke all barriers erected by the capitalists and their servants, advancing irresistibly. As Chairman Mao said: "The contradictions of capitalist society are manifested as acute antagonisms and conflicts, with a fierce class struggle and can not be solved by the same capitalist regime, but only by socialist revolution."

All social injustices existing in today's society dominated by monopoly capitalism, have their cause is not lack of economic resources and social, but in the chains holding back the forces of production and the private appropriation as a result of the policy of exploitation and robbery of big capitalists. And all the current social injustices are bound to get worse because the increase in the profit for the big financiers and for monopolies is increasingly dependent aggravation of living conditions of the vast majority of the Italian people. The absolute domination of the big financiers and the monopolies and their entire state machinery has

become the only obstacle that separates us from the conquest of socialism. Factories, arms work, unitary interest of the vast majority of the people, all the basic elements and structural for the building of socialism in our country. In order to set in motion these immense forces and advance society as a whole, it is necessary to break the state machine that sets the absolute right of big capital, it is necessary to establish a new social order under the revolutionary leadership of the working class. To deal with large private property, break the logic of individualism and selfishness that dominates bourgeois society, establish the dictatorship of the great majority of the people over the minority of exploiters. In a nutshell establish the dictatorship of the proletariat, and build socialism.

The Christian Democratic Party is the fundamental pillar of the power system of the big capitalists. Using the DC is the formation of blocking layers average middle-class and their parties, directed by the great capital, to administer the state apparatus in the name of common class interest. Under the direction and mediation of DC join the reactionary forces and the forces of reform in order to form a majority government and the blocking order dedicated to the fight against subversion and against the mass movements. Under the blows of the popular movement that advances, the power lock operated by the DC is broken repeatedly, and differences arise and conflicts within the bourgeoisie on the question of how and by what means we can obtain the repression of the mass movement.

The part of the middle class tied to the interests of the most reactionary of speculation and parasitism is the first to fall in fear of facing the growing mass movement, they panic, longs for the unleashing of military repression and immediately expresses its deep sympathy for the army and the police giving more emphasis to one type of regime, the police state. This wing of the bourgeoisie is represented by that of political forces that reformists called "the party of the adventure." The big monopolies favour their feelings of panic reactionary, but make every attempt to weave together the reformist farce to recover the "trust" of intermediate sectors of the masses and groped the isolation of the more combative of the popular movement. Of course, since the monopolies want to pay the minimum cost for this operation, the reformist affair should always be reduced to many "new ideas" and very few facts, many reforms "without cost" and very few concrete initiatives of social value. If certain privileged strata of the people are hoping for positive results from the plans of the reformist government of DC and his minions, will soon be disappointed. As you move to the "left", the government based on the DC and PSI can only be operating by repeatedly political corruption and mafia, bureaucracy and speculation. When the state machine serves a handful of big capitalists and

goes against all the working people, it can only be formed by reactionary elements, sold by servile and corrupt, students of the exploiters and always ready to profit from positions of power large or small they may have. And birds of prey in the hands of the ruling circles at various levels repeatedly disappear parts of public money that the big capitalists have left for the sake of reform. The DC current government, coven of reactionaries and reformers, after scoring taxes and repression as they wanted the reactionaries, is now preparing to play the farce of the reforms as they want the reformists. While this happens, the broad masses rise up in mass with increasing awareness claiming the fulfilment of the needs and desires of the working people.

The protest of the masses rising from below, expresses the voice of the millions of proletarians who needs completely disregarded by the political parties of bourgeois democracy. The popular masses are assuming consciousness that we are all the economic and social forces necessary to realize the great transformations. Dozens of years of work with immense sacrifices have formed a great resource that ended up in the hands of the monarchy and financial monopoly. Rejecting the logic of private appropriation of the broad masses require immediate and profound social transformations. The partial goals that rise from the will of the people show their character more and more anti-capitalist: equality, justice, freedom, peace, in the consciousness of the masses in struggle are increasingly seen as the fruits of the possible social revolution.

The workers claim the actual reduction of working time, the minimum wage for all, the elimination of unemployment considering it a crime, the elimination of the absurd divisions in dozens of qualifications, the general wage increase equal for all and suitable for a dramatic increase in the cost of living. They want to increase the ridiculous current share of family allowances, full pay periods of the disease, the complete prevention of the harm and injuries. Emigrants and all the people of the south and of poor areas demanding the return of workers to their home countries, the elimination of unemployment and the employment of all arms and all the resources for economic development and social equal across the nation . Young people demand the right to education for all and free of charge, to all students wage workers' children, the radical change of the school with the elimination of the absurd authority of the teaching and training of students in the collective choices with teachers and the joint management. Young people want the elimination of conscription to military service and the right to criticize corruption and authoritarianism in the army. The young and the intellectuals want to reject servitude to the system of capitalist exploitation and want to study and work to serve the people. The laborers demand the minimum wage throughout the year and adjusted for cost of living and want full equality with the assistance provided to the workers. The poor peasants demanding the expropriation of estates and the allocation of funds for the mechanization of the advice and peasant assemblies. They require that their products are sold in the city at the same price at which they are being paid. Pensioners demand the guaranteed minimum pension for all older, adjusted to cost of living. Women want the full equal pay, and the establishment of nurseries for the care of all children. The broad masses require a home for all workers, with adequate premises and the rent proportioned to the income of each family. They want the price freeze and the reduction of prices of all kinds of consumer products.

The great majority of the Italian people want that Italy fulfils a function of the anti-imperialist and peace in the world. At workplaces, neighbourhoods and towns, in schools and offices, there is a big movement of rejection of bourgeois democracy and the formation of moments of grassroots democracy as instruments of mobilization for the struggle of the masses against

the government. The people demand the freedom of assembly in factories and in all public places. The people want the freedom to demonstrate, strike, press, speech and assembly to assert its will on the minority that exercises the dictatorship state. All these claims of the masses are right and inalienable, and are the basis of all movements of protest and struggle. The Communists Marxist-Leninists support the claims and protests of the masses, are placed at the head of every fight and show the right way to achieve victory. We must be aware that all these demands of the masses are clearly antagonistic towards the big capitalists and the Government of the DC and his minions. All of these claims and protests have a common enemy: the private property and the absolute defense that the state apparatus is the property and privileges.

As long as the domain of private property exists and this machine state anything about what the masses want to be truly viable. For this reason, the first political turmoil that the Communists Marxist-Leninists must conduct is based on the slogan: "For the reforms, against the Government of the DC and of his servants." This agitation is based on the support of the mass struggle, on the complaint policy taken anywhere and efficiently, to grow the revolutionary mass movement and exposing the impotence and deception of reformism and revisionism, to isolate the large capital and join the masses around the revolutionary politics. The working class through its vanguard, the Communist Marxist-Leninist, asks the accession of the masses to his revolutionary program. Relying on the principle that reforms can only be the product of the revolution, the Communist Marxist-Leninists support a program that makes the unites all the demands of the masses in their sense of class and socialism. This program is the practical program of the revolutionary government, the form of political expression of state power by the working class, joining a united front in all the broad masses, For this reason, the Marxist-Leninist Communist stir among the masses the revolutionary program and the password:

Let us unite to build the Communist Party Marxist-Leninist and to organize the revolutionary mass movement

The Communists Marxist-Leninists are a small minority among the broad masses of workers and are intended to be relatively still a minority throughout the preparatory period of the revolutionary struggle. Yet these vanguard fighters are an animated special force, they are the best representatives of the broad masses of the people, have confidence in them and repeatedly win a majority in the proper orientation of struggle and leadership. The correspondence of the political line of the Communist Marxist-Leninist with the material interests of the broad masses makes this cutting-edge to blend in with the masses and to direct them towards victory.

In the very heart of the popular movement confront and collide two-line policy and principle, a line is genuinely representative of the real interests of the working masses, the other that

comes from the outside, is the line supported by the bourgeoisie, which repeatedly tries to confuse and divide the masses of solidarity and divert them from the correct revolutionary struggle.

This line is represented today by modern revisionism, the ally of the big capitalists and the government, which acts between the working class. This line must be fought and isolated in the popular movement, this is the necessary condition to advance to the legions compact masses towards revolutionary victory. The Marxist-Leninist Communists are fighting with all their strength to win the masses to the correct proletarian revolutionary line and the line to defeat reformist and revisionist. Under the blows of the growth of the mass movement and the fierce ideological and political struggle led by the Marxist-Leninists, the representatives of the reformist and revisionist line losing ground and foaming of fear and anger in the face of the extensive critical mass against them and against their policy. These representatives of the bourgeoisie in the ranks of the popular movement contemplate a vast operation reformist by which they would like to retrieve the undisputed leadership in the popular movement by isolating the Communists and Marxist-Leninist revolutionary forces.

At the level of government would like to achieve an alliance with the reformists and moderate DC for a government shifted to the left from that achieve these reforms make the "common interest" of industrialists and workers against parasitism and various "backwardness" of society. And so in all sectors of society, with a completely illusory pattern of progressive democracy in which political power should subtract power gradually to the monopolistic forces. Anyone note the dominance of the economic powers on political power and the sharp contrast between the interests of capital and the interests of workers, can not understand the character completely utopian reformist and revisionist line. The only outcome that can get this line is the failure of the workers' movement and popular, and therefore the strengthening of the reaction and the more rapid degenerative process of the whole capitalist society. And this is the reality in our country: constant reaction is the flag of the government, the fascist thugs in the military and other state assets are the filthiest scoundrels preparing to destroy any semblance of democracy.

The Marxist-Leninist Communists, formed in the school of thought of Mao Tse-tung, were able to understand the true nature of modern revisionism. Chairman Mao has taught us the true and profound conception of socialism, has demonstrated that socialism is generally opposed to the bourgeois social system, he taught what man is a socialist and the great value of the struggle against selfishness. Chairman Mao has taught us that revisionism is the result of the intervention of the bourgeoisie in the contradictions among the people and in the ranks of communist, sweetened by the bullets that attract the revolutionaries lacking vigilance towards the renewal of the bourgeois conception of the world and towards the abandonment the revolutionary struggle. These lessons allow Communist Marxist-Leninists to fight constantly against opportunism at last to prevent any penetration of the bourgeoisie in the file communist, and to fight and criticize this opportunism among the privileged sectors of the masses, showing them how to compromise with the bourgeoisie does not bring anything

good.
