Over 70 have been arrested since May '69 and some have years. The masses in various areas will never be fooled by these vicious attempts to spread confusion, lies and slanders as well as threats and incimidation.

In Ann Arbor, ever since May of last year, national minority students who took up the cause of American people have continously been harassed and threatened by the FBI. Their friends and supporters were also harassed by these fascist agents. In a vain attempt to intimidate and create terror amongst them the FBI repeately called them by telephone.

On November 28, 1972, the American Student Movement issued a statement supporting the struggles of students at Southern University and denouncing the fascist repression used against them, including the cold-blooded murder of two black students. A summary of the statement follows.

In the course of struggling against racial discrimination and the university curriculum denounced by the students as "geared to the continuation of the oppressive conditions that black and other poor people are subjected to", and for a greater say in university affairs, housing improvements, food and classroom facilities and the resignation of leading fascist administrators, the students were savagely attacked by the state government and the police. The Acamedic Activities Committee (A.A.C.) recently formedheld its first public meeting on Dec. 4,1972; a summation of this meeting is here reprinted from the A.A.C.-Newsletter, No.1, Dec. 12, 1972.

Topic: The problem of scarcity of natural resources. Speakers: Prof.M. Yoss Depart ment of Physics. Prof. C. Olson-Depart ment of Natural Resources

... The meeting started with the speto the problem of raw materials and energy. He said that the limitation of prohibitingly expensive cost to extract them. Today, he added, there is not an absolute scarcity of natural resources but there could be scarcity in relation to a particular resource. For example in USA there is not yet scarcity of crude oil but if the nues, certainly in the near future there will be an actual scarcity of it; scarcity that will inevitably cause a conflict of interest between at the same rate it will have to find any means to acquire it. In regard to nuclear power he said that, although it could be used to supply nevitably bring in its wake social problems, for example its possible misuse, nuclear pollution, possible sabotage etc., and technical problems owing to its complexity. If this is the situation what can be the solution? from page 6, column 2) ted by giving his interpretation of the development of the history of mankind In essence he said that the nce between the social systems in other historical eras as for example, the slave society, and the actual social system in USA today is that in the former the people were exploited, while in the latter they are free from exploitation; but even today there is still a c-ertain form of exploisation which, he said, is tourism. On the basis of these premises, Prof. Olson, went on to claim that there is no scarcity of natural resources but instead there is scarcity of people; there is a lack, he said, of people who "th-ink". People who think of how to use natural resources not only for mat-er listic values but also for other values such as recreational and esthetic ones. But man is selfish by nature, he later added, and in the final analysis all problems nkind final analysis all problems faces are due to this essence of human nature.

Then in a serious atmosphere the general discussion started with a participant who said that we alrea- - The nature of man dy have the solution to the scarcity of natural resources, the solution is the full use of the technological capabilities. He emphasized that the scarcity of energy could be eliminated with an extensive application of nuclear power, which is rendered impossible in this country by the obstruction made by the capitalist corporations whose interests depend on the production of oil. The above views, as another participant pointed out, are inherently incorrect, because of the lack of consideration of the whole political and social reality, He pointed out, to discuss about natural resources the following three points should be fully considered:a) the eno-rmous creativity of human labor to transform nature, b) the development throughout human history of the means of production and c) the whole socioeconomic and political system that is subject to change. He supported his position with various examples such as: the great transformation of nature made by the labor of the Chinese people since liberation and the development of human production from the stage of hunting and fishing to that of cultivation of land. He further stressed that any theory that does not take into consideration the above three points cannot be considered as a scientific theory about natural resources as it does not reflect the concrete reality.

With regard to the question of famines that are seriously affecting some parts of the world today, especially India, on the one hand Prof. Olson stated that USA had the capability of solving the famine problem in India but she could not do it

because if she were to do so, it would affect the economy of some European countries who are at present exporting food to India. On the other hand, a participant said that the solution to the problem cah only be accomplished by a "world socialist governement". But thes views were strongly contested by another participant, who pointed out that the real cause of famine in India is the exploitation and oppression of the majority of the Indian people, inparticular the peasants, by the landlord and money-lender class and the only solution could come from the Indian people alone, in taking their destiny into their own hands, just as the Chinese people had done in solving their problems.

After the formal part of the

meeting was concluded, people with great enthusiasm continued discussing their views informally.
