SYRIAN NEWSPAPERS "ROGERS PLAN"

Syrian newspapers have recently published a series of editorials and articles sternly condemning the "Rogers Plan" and the "peaceful solution" plot of U.S. Imperialism. They pointed out that Nixons plots are bound to end in failure whereas

the Arab people are sure to be victorius

"Al Sarah" said in an editorial on aug.

19 that the U.N. Security council resolution and the Rogers Plan are in essence aimed at eventually liquidating the Pal-estine issue and stabilizing the Zionist on the soil of Palestine, After pointing out that the Arab people have all the conditions for defeating the aggressors, the editorial emphasized that so long as the Arab people bring into full play all their military and economic potentialities and their manpower to serve the war, they will certainly be able to foil all the "peaceful solution " plots.

The same paper pointed out in another editorial on aug. 12 that the Rogers Plan dished up by U.S. Imperialism was designed to achieve the objectives which had not been achieved during the aggres-sion of June 5, 1967. The editorial said

that the continuation and intensification of the struggle will inevitably accelerate the unity of the progressive forces to deal with the U.S. plot of annexing this region The upsurge of the Palestine resistance movement as well as the law of the development of history will inevitably bring all U.S. schemes to failure.

Aneditorial of "Al Baath" said on aug. 17 that recognition of Israel and respect for its sovereignty and independance are the major objectives of the Security Council "resolution" and the "Rogers Plan". Recognition of Israels sovereignty implied the liquidation of the Palestinian revolutionary cause.

The paper said in an article on aug. I6 that the policy of the U.S. is to supply Israel with all kinds of arms and all possible aid to overthrow by every effort the progressive Arab regimes and undermine the Palestinian revolution. But the article pointed out, "to date, nothing indicates the success of Nixons policy in this region The Palestinian revolution fully capable of thwarting Nixon's policy.

MEXICAN-AMERICANS STRUGGLE AGAINST VIOLENT REPRESSION

On Saturday August 29th Mexican-Amrican demonstrators in East Los Angeles California vigorously resisted a cowardly attack by 500 police.

Several thousand Mexican-Americans had gathered in East Los Angeles to pro-test U.S. imperialist aggression in Indo-China and to protest the genocidal plan of the U.S. imperialists of using Mexican-Americans as cannon-fodder in their wars of aggression.

Using the pretext of "looting in the area" the fascist U.S. police attacked in force the peaceful rally and tried to disperse the demonstrators with tear gas. But taking the road of active resistance, the demonstrators replied to the police with rocks , bottles and fire bombs and injured 25 police and damaged 25 patrol cars.

On the following day, in the same district, 500 Mexican-Americans, defying the heavy police patrol, gathered to hail the heroic fighting spirit of the 200 people arrested in the previous day's fighting. Again police unjustifiably attacked the demonstrators and again were justifiably met with fierce resistance and revolutionary violence.

The just struggle of the Mexican-American and the other progressive and democratic people in the U.S. is bound to win. As Chairman Mao says: "Lam convinced that the American people

who are fighting valiantly will ultimately win victory and that the fascist rule in the United States will inevitably be defeated."

NOVA SCOTIA FISHERMEN PERSIST IN STRIKE

The 250 striking trawler-fishermen of Canso Strait in Nova Scotia have been fighting two imperialist owned fishing companies for five months to win the right to organize into the union

After five months of sneering at the workers' demands, of offering treacherous "alternative union plans" designed to sap the workers' strength, of sending police to attack the workers, and of sentencing workers to jail through fascist labor laws and courts, the comprador state machine is now trying to appear in its guise as an "impartial mediator".

A so-called "industrial inquiries

A so-called board", made up of Mackasey, the labor minister for the lackey federal government of Trudeau; McKeough, Nova Scotia labor minister; and "Justice" Nathan Green from the Supreme Court of Canada. has brought down its "recommendations".

DISEASE IS INCURABLE

Chinese Workers Smash Imperialist 'Expert' Line Use Mao Ise-tung Thought To Build

OURS is a small rural health clinic, but we often have patients who come to us with eye diseases that had been troubling them for a long time. Some of them had been told by bourgeois medical authorities that their

Were we to accept the verdicts of the "authorities"? Guided by Chairman Mao's philosophical thinking, our doctors and nurses freed their minds from accepted rules and ideas and tried new treatments. In the last three years we cured several hundred patients of their "incurable" eye diseases and restored their sight. Our own gain: When medical workers use Mao Tsetung Thought to break away from their blind faith in the "authorities", they can cure the blindness of their patients.

From the Realm of Necessity to the Realm of Freedom

In the winter of 1966 a peasant woman named Huang Kai-lan came to us. She had lost her sight for some thirty days from acute glaucoma. According to both Chi-nese and foreign medical literature, the onset of acute cases was so severe that within 24 to 48 hours severe that within 24 to 48 hours necrosis of the retina set in, the optic nerve lost its power of function, and the patient would never be able to see again. Huang Kailan had already been to several big hospitals but was told by the bourgeic authorities that he case was geois authorities that her case was

As we exchanged opinions in low voices, the patient spoke up. "Why don't you give it a try?" she said. "Things are done by man. Whether a disease can be cured or not depends on the men handling the case. With Chairman Mao leading us, surely there is no knot that cannot be untied." As we exchanged opinions in

The peasant woman's words were a lesson in proletarian faith ized the doctors

and nurses in a study of Chairman Mao's teaching, "The history of mankind is one of continuous development from the realm of necessity to the realm of freedom." Windows opened in our minds. Yes, is not the history of medicine one of continuously turning incurable diseases into curable ones? A history of continuously advancing from the realm of nec essity to the possible ultimately to know the objective world. As long as we apply the invincible Mao Tsetung Thought, practice and sum up our experience continuously, we are sure to find treatments for any kind of disease. On the other hand. if we do not do anything about a disease simply because the medical books say it cannot be cured, then it will remain incurable even after

With this new understanding we were eager to try. We also told ourselves we must combine revolutionary daring with a scientific

a thousand years.

We made careful examinations of Huang Kai-lan's eyes and compared the findings with our previous experience. We found that blindness from acute glaucoma did not necessarily result from necrosis of the retina or the complete loss of functional power of the optic nerve. Loss of vision can also re-sult from serious edema of the cornea, increase of tension, partial damage to the retina and nerve or temporary loss of their functional power.

First we applied drugs to eliminate the edema, then operated on the eyes to reduce tension. restored the functional power of the retina and optic nerve with drugs and acupuncture. Forty days later Huang Kai-lan was able to see again. She gazed long at a portrait of Chairman Mao and "Long live Chairman

Since then we have treated 36 more patients who were totally blind from acute glaucoma, some long as forty days, restored the sight of most of them.

Practice helped us see that whether a disease is curable or not is a relative matter. There is no unbreachable gap between the two aspects of this contradiction. Given certain conditions, an incurable disease becomes curable. Most important of the conditions is the medical workers' political con-sciousness, expressed in a revolutionary daring to practice and through it gain a knowledge of the laws of the diseases and apply this knowledge. If the medical workers are only concerned with protecting their reputation and material gains, they will never find the cure, even for easily curable diseases.

.Finding the Laws

All things in the world develop according to certain laws which are objective and independent of man's subjective will. When we have not understood the laws of a disease, we cannot cure it. Once we understand them, we can apply them to cure the disease.

Repeated practice and constant

search for the objective laws enabled us to find effective treatment for leukoma, or a dense white opacity of the cornea resulting from untimely treatment of a cor-neal ulcer. The opacity may reduce the vision or be so serious as to make the patient to all antents and purposes blind. Leukoma is common in the countryside and we had long wanted to find a cure. But all the available literature offered only one method and that was to remove the diseased cornea and replace it with a cornea taken from the eye of a person who has just died. This could not be easily done in rural clinics.

But was there no other way? We thought of Chairman Mao's words, "We cannot just take the words, "We cannot just take the beaten track traversed by other countries in the development of technology and trail behind them at a snail's pace." "The Chinese people have high aspirations, they have ability, and they will cer-tainly catch up with and surpass advanced world levels in the not too distant future." man Mao's teaching, "Often, cor-rect knowledge can be arrived at only after many repetitions of the process leading from matter to con-sciousness and then back to matter, that is, leading from practice to knowledge and then back to prac-

We reviewed our failures and looked for the reasons, then decided that both the needle and the cat-gut insertions were not deep enough to cause a strong reaction and quick absorption of the catgut. We decided to try deeper insertion.

But would it be dangerous? We were debating this when we heard of the PLA. doctors' success in curing deaf-mutes with deep insertion of the expuncture needle.

Our discussions became warmer.

fection and quicker removal of the white opacity. "Discover the truth through practice, and again through practice verify and de-velop the truth." We tried deep insertion of needle and catgut on 23 patients and got remarkable results in all cases.

Continue the Advance

"In the fields of the struggle for production and scientific experiment, mankind makes constant progress and nature undergoes constant change; they never remain at the same level." Chairman Mao's words showed us we must not remain satisfied with initial successes but must continue to find new ways to understand the truth through constant practice. We had through constant practice. We had taken a leap forward in curing leukoma, but it did not mean there was no room for further improve-ment.

From a P.I.A. hospital's advanced experience in curing the after-effects of polio with suepuncture, we learned that stimulation of the nerves could be increased by rotating the needle in the acupuncture points. We believed we could do the same with the optic nerve. After trying it on our nerve. After trying it on our-selves, we applied the new treat-ment to 21 leukoma patients in two months and found it even more effective than the previous treat-

This told us there is no end to the probing of the laws of disease development and freedom in curing can be gained continuously.

We have faced a situation in which after we cured one ailment. a new one appeared in the same ometimes more difficult to treat than the first one.

than the first one.

Hsu Pi-fu, a brigade cadre, came to us with old retinitis. We cured him. After some time he came again, this time with central retinitis. We were puzzled by the development and turned to Chairman Mao's philosophical teachings for an answer. We found the key in these passages from On Contradiction: "There are many contradictions in the process of development of a complex thing, and one of them is necessarily the principal contradiction" and "The old processe ands and the new one begins. ess ends and the new one begins

We decided to look for solution in our traditional medicine. Every-one suggested ideas and methods. One doctor suggested adapting a new treatment which P.L.A. doc-tors devised for bronchial asthma — the insertion of catgut into acupuncture points to strengthen the effects of stimulation and tissue

We inserted catgut into the two acupuncture eye points of the pa-tient and waited 20 days. Nothing happened. The second time we administered acupuncture treat-ment first and then inserted the catgut. Still there was no notice able therapeutic effect. A few be-came discouraged, but most com-rades remained confident. They encouraged each other with Chairthe staff to study Chairman Mao's teaching, "If you want to know the taste of a pear, you must change the pear by eating it yourself." With the advances made in contraceptive technique, the Neo-Malthusians here added one point to Malthus' argument, that in contraceptive man had acquired a preventive check to population which is under his conscious control.

And in another article, "Infortunately Malthus' great discovery has not yet formed any part of the curriculum of the educated classes, and hence but a few of these are sufficiently instructed to be able to enlighten with their poorer neighbours. These are left objetiown ignorant leaders, who tell them in tyde-Park and elsewhere, that overcrowding, deer work, sweating and starvation wages, are dub, copressive laws, or the tyranny of capitalinal propagation. In this free counter, lives are chiefly governed by the law of Nature, and their miseries mostly arise out of their own infringement of these paramount laws."

irrational and reckless propagation, especially indulged in by the indigent and wage-earning classes."

Margaret Sanger, the first propagandist for birth control in the USA, speaking at the Fifth International Neo-Malthusian and Birth Control Conference in 1922, said that "From the dawn of Conference in 1922, said that "From the dawn of humanity, and even the dawn of civilization, we have recognised that there are two fundamental urges which have prodded mankind forward. These have been hunger and sex. While they have both been neglected factors to a great extent in our recognition of them, the French Revolution aroused the whole civilized world to realization of the fact that the urge of hunger cannot be ignored without dire consequences to all.

The other urge of sex, however, has been almost entirely ignored, and it is now time for us to awaken the conscience of the present generation to a realization of the consequences to civilization unless we accept this instinct, and recognizing it as being fully fundamental and equally dynamic and fateful in its consequences as hunger."

Margaret Sanger states her point quite clearly; she is afraid of the revolution that will destroy imperialism and capitalism. Every porperson is a potential revolutionary, so one must keep down the numbers of the poor. Her idealism cannot grasp either history or the economics of the present society. Reducing the population in no way changes this requirement (this would make matters worse by reducing the number of people employed). Neo-Malthusians specifically ignore the development of the means of production. The most straightforward illustration of this is the theory of Pearl (the Biology of Population Growth 1925). He wisely avoids giving any analysis of the causes of famines. Instead he declares "India is the great bastion of democracy in Asia. It is the obvious conitrerfoil to Red China. Despite almost incredibly stupid political strategy, Red China's morrores in material development undoubtedly has a powerful appeal to the politically "un-

committed" third of the world's population. They are ill informed and misinformed. They have few sound bases for judging what happens in Mao Tse-tung's domain. If Mao reaches only half his goals and if five million people starve to death in India — or ten million — it will be difficult for the uncommitted and the uninformed to each any other conclusion than that Communism is superior."

He feels bad about the starving millions. But "By a special and largely fortuitous combination of circumstances we Americans have been able to reach a level of material comfort without precedent in the history of the world. This most of us have identified with a penultimate, if not an utilimate, good, and with the zeal of dedicated missionaries we are making at least the gesture of extending it to the rest of the world". "We need, I think, not apologize for trying to maintain a high standard of living in America, though many of us wish there might be more emphasis on quality than quantity. It is only because we have a high standard that we have enable to give as much help as we can to our fellow man."

"The understanding of nature's laws, evolved by a tiny minority of the human race, and applied to ends both constructive and destructive, is impressive. But this understanding is, unfortunately restricted to a miniscule proportion of the nearly three billion people in the world. And some of the most brilliant insights are given to such small fractions of even the well-informed that understanding them has limited or often non-cristent influence." The particular brilliant insight that has failed to take root is that of the need to prevent population growth!

What could be done? "One of the most radical suggestions as to fertility control came from Dr. Homin Bhabha, President of the Indian Atomic Energy Commission, at the 1985 meeting in New Delhi of the International Planned Parenthood Federation. "What Indian needs, said Dr. Bhabha in effect, is not the perfect contraceptive but something that will reduce overall fertility. If the Indian birth rate could be cut by 30%, economic, development could overtake population growth and we could raise our standard of living. "What we need, he concluded, is an antifertility agent to be added to the rice grain or salt, that would cut our birth rate by this amount." (concluded)

The new process contains new con-tradictions and begins its own his-tory of the development of contra-dictions."

Applying these principles to the atient, we found that at a given patient, we found that at a given period, there is a principal symptom which often covers up another not easily discovered. The doctor usually concentrates on treating the principal symptom. This is necessary, but not enough. The doctor's responsibility is not only to treat the obvious and principal symptom but also the examine and find the hidden'symptoms, control them and remove them before they develop further. Otherwise the secondary symptom may become the principal one at a certain time and may cause further trouble. When we treated Hsu Pi-fu for his old retinitis, we only eliminated the inflammation but did nothing about the exudate resulting from the inflammation and this even-tually caused central retinitis,

tually caused central retunits.

Once we are clear about the relations between the principal and secondary symptoms and the possibility of one turning into the other, we gain an overall view of the disease and can foresee its development. Then we can apply different treatment at different stages in a planned and step-by-step way. We can remove the possibility of complications and after-effects in one treatment. With improved treatment we give better proved treatment we give better service to the patients.

Hsu Pi-fu's second symptom, central retinitis, could have led to atrophy of the optic nerve and cause blindness. But because we foresaw the underlying symptom and took measures, we were able to prevent such atrophy. Hsu Pi-fu kept his sight.
