NEW UPSURGE IN PRISON REBELLIONS!

SCLEDAD, CALIF.

San Francisco, Nov. 15 -a 13-day hunger strike by 50
prisoners at Soledad prison
was reported ended today
when the prison authorities
delivered writts replies to
the prisoners 18 demands.
Among the demands were:
quicker delivery of books a
and masarines from the outside, hot meals at noon,
ellmination of bugs in cells,
and an end to certain restrictions or visitors. The
prisoners also expressed
firm support for Argela
Davis and the Soledad Davis and the Soledad Brothers, three young Black prisoners unjustly charged with murdering a guard.

San Francisco, Nov. 15 -- Pascist prison authorities held all prisoners in their individual cells in a "general lockup" for the ninth straight day today after a large number of prisoners went on a work strike last

went on a work week.

The warden declared,
"I don't negotiate when the institution is in a state of insurrection," rejecting the prisoners' 31 demands out of hand. The prisoners were placed in general lockup last week after the wast majority of them struck against fescist persecution by the authorities of the

jail and the courts. Early this week the authorities lifted the lockup, but reinstated it again when more than half of the prisoners stil refused to work.

One of the main demands of the prisoners is for a change in the maximum security disciplinary proceedings. At present the brisoners have no right to appeal or communication with the outside world once placed in maximum-security cells. One man has been held in maximum security for three years without ever for three years without ever being told the reason why.

to 11 a day, while admitting
that the prisoners' demands
are just, the fascist warden
claimed that he could not
possibly pay the raise. This

action agminst them.

If the course of the debate, many arab and afromalian delegates strongly denounced U.S. imperialism and the israell aggressors for the monstrous crime of massariring the Arab and Falestinian people, U.A.R. Amidst the voices of condemation of the delegates of Arab countries, chief delegate of the United States Charles Yost tried to justify the crimes committed by U.S. imperialism. He kept peddling the "Rogers Flan" and advocated that the Arab countries and the Israell aggressors should "establish confidence". The Iraqi delegate pointed o, out that the so-called "peace initiative" on the mideast question "mims at the complete liquidation of the Falestinian people and their sallant resistance movement". The U.A.H. delegate pointed out that "there is no confidence

between the occupied and occupier, between the victim and the aggressor, and between countries at war," de said that the Arab people and "the Falestinian people and "the Falestinian people" were victims of Israel's expansionist and racist policles" and that one must "recognize the inalienable and incontestable rights of e the Falestinian people".

Delegates from Albania and other countries also de denounced the crimes committed by U.S. imperialism and its collaborator and running dogs. They expressed warm support for the just struggle of the Arab and Falestinian people.

Amidst voices of strong condenation by delegates of various countries during the debate which placed U.S. imperialism and its running dog Israel in unprecedented isolation, the United States could not but withdraw its "draft resolution". A "Lew York Times" report said that of the 39 speakers during the first five days of the debate beginning October 26, only the delegates of the United States and Israel tried to whitewash their own crimes by quibbling, while the others "bitterly condemned Israel and the United States" and "the verbal bullets were flying". "The United States had hoped to find allies" but the answer was a "deafening stlence", the report said.

Ignoring their protests, the union bosses continue to collaborate with the companies to make this attack on the workers' basic right to a living.

accused with "carrying concealed" and "loaded" firearms
during the demonstration.

into a powerful battle with the fascist police after the police attacked the people without warning, in the course of the struggle, the police shot and killed a Mexican-American newsman Ruben Salazar, who was peacefully sitting in a bar, thus incurring a blood debt that will not be forgotten by the Mexican-American people. Salazar's assassin was cleared in the fascist courts, It is clear that the fascist legal authorities are engaged in a campaign of persecution against the militant Mexican-American national minority. Moreover, in the meat packing and food processing trades which hold important trades which hold important positions in Argentina's national economy, many firms have either passed into the hands of foreign capital, principally U.S. capital, or

nands of foreign capital, principally U.S. capital, or gone bankrupt.

The plunder and exploitation by U.S. monopoly capital have brought about a series of economic disasters to Argentina. The nation's external debts have increased sharply from 2,649 million U.S. dollars in 1968 to 3,209 million dollars in 1970. The currency was devalued four times between 1966 and last June. Under the blows of U.S. capital, a large number of Argentine industrial and commercial enterprises have gone bankrupt. The cost of living increased manifold in several years. According to obviously minimized official figures,

the cost of living index, taking 1960 as 100, was 624 by the end of 1968. A recent report soid that the cost of living went up another 17.1 per cert in the first ten months of this year. Urem-ployment has increased sharp-ly following economic deteri-oration. Statistics show a total of 1.5 million people are jobless or semi-urem-

The broad working Easses in Argertina have come to realize that the intensified plunder and exploitation by U.S. moropoly capital are the root cause of theirsufferings. The channel grew longer and longer

TIME: One o'clock in the after-noon of September 14, 1968. spite her injuries and severe Place: The marshalling yard of the bleeding she shouts, "Chiu-chiu, Chuchow railway station in Hunan province. A bustle of activity as trains are made up for dispatch all over the country. South of the sta-tion a section of freight cars runs free after being released by the shunting engine. Three children under six years of age playing on the track don't notice the cars bearing down on them and now only a dozen metres away.

Little Red Soldier Tai Pi-jung, just ten years old, is passing. Tak ng in the situation, she is shocked.

Chairman Mao's teaching rings in her ears: "To die for the people is weightier than Mount Tai." Without a moment's thought for her own safety she leaps onto the track. She gets one boy away. The line of cars is closer.

"When we die for the people it is a worthy death," she hears Chairman Mao's warm voice urging her on. Gaining new strength, she jumps up on the track and carries the four-year-old girl to safety. Now the cars are only two or three metres away.

"Re resolute, fear no s "Be resolute, tear no sacritice and surmount every difficulty to win victory." Mao Tsetung Thought guides Pi-jung to fight bravely. Pushing herself to the utmost, she jumps back, grabs the third child and pushes him off the track. The little boy is safe, but our heroine's left arm and leg are crushed under the wheels.

thought is for the little ones. Despite her injuries and severe bleeding she shouts, "Chiu-chiu, Hung-hung, An-an, go away quickly. Don't mind me." She raised it and looked at it time and again, saving cheerfully, "I still have my right hand, I am still able to write quotations from Chairman Mao!" For a week, Pi-jung remained in a crisis. While semi-conscious she did not recognize her mother or father, but when the comrades brought Chairman Mao's portrait, she opened her eyes and called softly, "Chairman Mao!"

Last December, her stump be-Last December, her stump be-came infected and a second opera-tion was necessary. The next morning she studied Chairman Mao quotations as usual. Each time a new instruction from Chairman Mao was broadcast over the radio, she wrote it down at once, copied it many times and memorized it

Anxious to get back to school to make revolution and continue her studies, she often got out of bed on her own to practise jumping on her one leg. Again and again she fell, but each time she struggled up again. Her leg swollen and her face black and blue, she stubborn-ly kept on. She even began sweeping the floor and doing other light jobs.
