In late morning, the fascist authorities ordered
their lackey police to attack the NCCF office in order to evict the Fanthers,

The NCCF had sandbasged the
walls of its abartment in
anticipation, of just such
an attack and the masses
were still angry at the earlier fascist atrocities.
When the police moved in to
the project, hiding behind a
tank and wearing armored
vests and helmets and carrying a large number of guns,
the people including some
progressive whites, on the
streets and lawns and
blocked their way. The Fanthers issued a statement declaring that they had been



Arrogantly holding a news conference and parading his fascist generals, secretary of defense Laird boasted of the "heroism" of the aggressive landing. But all his puffed-up pride was underout by the fact that, despite his "intelligence", no prisoners were found in the camp. Thus the "intelligence" of the imperialists was revealed once again to be built on dreams, just as it was last May when the imperialists claimed to have located the "headquarters" for the National Liberation Front of South Viet Nam only to find it "not there". It is quite clear that the masses of people in Viet Nam will not give Mr. Mixon or Laird the time of day as far as "intelligence" is concerned, but will answer every intrusion on their sacred soil with guns.

The ground raid was carried out one hour after 250 U.S. planes, including supersonic sup planes, ineffectually bombed a large number of targets in North Viet Nam in their second major raid in the last week. According to reports in the burgeois press, they were only able to set a hundred or so trucks burning. Is it not clear that the imperialists have become only a thorn in the side of mighty People's Man? Ras not Viet Nam

Has not Viet Nam proved Chairman Mao's thesis once and for all: "A WEAK NATION CAN DEFEAT A STRONG, A SMALL NATION CAN DEFEAT A TAZ TAZ PRODIE OP A SMALL A SMALL NATION CAN DEFRAT A BIG. THE PEOPLE OF A SMALL COUNTRY CAN CERTAILX! DEFRAT AGGRESSION BY A BIG COUNTRY, IP ONLY THEY DARK TO RISE IN STRUCGLE, TAKE UP ARMS AND GRASP IN THEIR COUNTRY. THIS IS A LAW OP HISTORY." - The spokemman of the Central Committee of the Lactian Patrictic Pront, in a statement on November 17, said that the shooting down of a U.S. imperialist reconnaissance plane in the air space of the Democratic Republic of Viet Nam on Lovember 13 was a splendid achievement of the valiant army and people of Viet Nam, according to a Pathet Lac radio broadcast yesterday.

The Lactian Patrictic Front sternly denounces this criminal act of U.S. imperialism and the nonsense uttered by U.S. defence secretary Melvin Laird in a vain attempt to cover up the crime, the statement continued. The Lactian Patrictic Front fully supports the stand of the Democratic Republic of Viet Nam as stated in the November 14 statement of the D.R.V.N. foreign ministry spokesman.

The statement said that on November 13, 1970, after the downing by the North Viet Nam People's Armed Porces of a U.S. spy plane in the air space of the Democratic Republic of Viet Nam, U.S. defence secretary Melvin Laird declared that the United States would remain ready to "take appropriate action in response". This is an extremely absurd and war-like statement which exposes further the obstinate aggressive nature of the U.S. imperialists.

The statement pointed out that the punishment of the U.S. imperialists for their aggressive activities by the Vietnamese people right in their country is a just act, fully conforming to the sacred right of every nation to self-defence. Helvin Laird grants the United States the right to carry out spying activities against the D.R.V.N., freely occupy South Viet Nam's urban centres and deny the Vietnamese people's right to oppose these acts. Laird's statement constitutes an open challenge to the Vietnamese people as well as to the peace-and-justice-loving people all over the world.

The statement pointed out that in order to liberate the South, defend the North and proceed to the peaceful reunification of the country, the South Vietnamese people are resolved to persevere in and step up their war against U.S. aggression and for national salvation, dealing yet heavier blows at the U.S. aggressors and their troops and satellite troops from South Viet Nam.

SOUTH VIETNAMESE PATRICTIC PORCES WIN PRESH SUCCESSES IN EXTENSIVE ATTACKS ON

Hanoi. Nov. 19 (Hsinhua)

- The South Vietnamese
Armed Forces and people, by
developing the mighty power
of Feople's War, attained
fresh successes in extensive
extacks on the U.S. and puppet troops in various battlefields in late October
and early November, according to the South Viet Nam
Glai Phong Press Agency.

The regional forces and
guerrillas in Quang Nam,
Quang Ngai, Quang Tri and
Thua Thien provinces in central Trung Bo, overcoming
the difficulties caused by
recent serious floods, persisted in struggle and severely punished the U.S. and
puppet troops which, taking
advantage of the floods, salied out for "mopping-up"
operations,

Intercepting the enemy
troops out on "mopping-up"
missions, the guerrillas and
regional forces in Que Son
and Thien Photo districts of
quang Kam porvince wiped out
over 150 U.S. and puppet
troops, brought down 3 helicopters and destroyed a
military vehicle from october 30 to November 5.

In successive intercertions from october 26 to November 5, the guerrillas and
regional forces in Binh Son,
Son Tinh, Tu Ngta and Mo Duc
districts of Quang Ngai province put nearly 170 U.S.

Let us ask Mr. Laird, why should the U.S. government dispatch tens of thousands of miles away from the United States proper "to protect the lives of its men? United States proper "to protect the lives of its men? Uvbiously it was brazen aggression, yet Laird called it "to protect the lives of its men? U.S. imperialism has landed itself in an extremely embarrassed posi-

gangster logic!
At present, U.S. imperialism has landed itself in an
extremely embarrassed position and is at the end of
its tether in its war of aggression against Indo-China.
But Laird's statement again
shows that it will continue shows that it will continue to make a desporate struggle like a cornered beast. The way to deal with such imperialism which is aggressive by nature is to trounce it severely and put it to death. It can be decidedly said that the day when Laird takes "appropriate action in response" is precisely the time when U.S. inverialism suffers still more disastrous defeat on the battle-field in Irdo-China. If field in Indo-China. you do not believe it, wait and see.

ANGRY STUDENTS RISE AGAINST POLICE AT OHIO STATE!

AGAINST POLICI

Columbus, O., Nov. 24 -Progressive youth and students wared fierce battles asainst the fascist police
here Friday and Saturday
nights. Reacting to contiruous harssment by the reactionary authorities, the
students took up bottles and
other debris to throw at the
police. The assistant fire
chief was hit in the face
with a brick as he directed
fire-hose attacks on the
students and the Columbus
"safety director" had his
car showered with bottles.
Many police car windows
were smashed and \$43,000 damage was done to exploitative stores, expecially to
a gouging textbook store
near campus. At least one
student was shot by police.
The bourgeois press had
been desperately trying for
days to whip up enthusiasm
for this last game in the
football season, in order to
divert the people's attention away from fascist
lixon's lastest war adventures. But the progressive
students waged revolutionary cultural war against
this reactionary cultural
attack. A large banner was
hung from an apartment window on High Street, the main

this reactionary cultural attack. A large banner was hung from an apartment window on High Street, the main street neer campus, saying "football is a U.S. Plot to keep Feople Ignorant!" C—ther progressive students and faculty members sold many copies of FEOPLE'S MASHICA BAILY members before the fighting broke out, the political consciousness of the USU students, high since the three-week struggle against police and national guard last spring, has developed to grasp the importance of struggle on the cultural front in order to remove all the ideological props of the bourgeoiste from the minds of the people and mobilize them for revolution.

ened fascist authorities claimed the bottle-throwing had reached a "tolerable limit" when glass began to fill Bigh St. Then they, launched the police attacks. Using shotguns filled with wooden pellets, fire hoses and tear gas the fascist police viciously repressed the people. One youth ran down an alley to escape. He was shot in cold-blood by a fascist officer and later was charged with "resisting arrest" and "failing to obey the officer's orders." This is the gangster logic of the

was charged with "resisting arrest" and "failing to obey the officer's orders." This is the gangster logic of the fascists: charge the victim with the crime.

On Saturday it took the boasted riot squad two hours to disperse the fighting students. Earlier, safety director, Hughes, after nis car was pelted, complained about the scarcity of student marshals which the fascists attempted to mobilize to do the job of the police. But the students refused to be led down the blind alley of fighting contradictions among the people, and focused their struggle against the main enery, the fascist police and authorities.

This new rising of the OSUs students is an excellent development. It comes just at the time when the pacifiets and other opportunists of the holy alliance on the Kent State campus and elsewhere are attempting to turn the struggle against the murderers of the Kent students onto the non-vioulent path and make it a leading example to convince the students to lie down and be passive in the face of fescist Nixon. But the students have the fundamental right to use revolutionary violence to wipe out their oppressor. A warm salute to the leading example of the CSU students in making use of this right!

ses stood their ground and showered the police with rocks and bottles and con-stantly denounced them with all the anger and hatred of 350 years of blood debts at the hands of the U.S. imperialists.

the name of the six lapst-lailsts. The immensely powerful u-nity and militancy of this stand deeply shook the fas-cist authorities, who were not prepared to fight a war just yet. The authorities wavered and claimed they didn't want a "bloodbath" (after three centuries of atrocities against Black people and other American people, bloodbaths are sud-denly "undesirable"; this happens whenever fascist

people, bloodbaths are suddenly "undesirable"; this happens whenever fascist blood is about to be shed). As night fell the authorities pulled the police out, announcing that they would "allow" the Panthers 24 hours to test the anti-trespassing law in court. An hCCF representative, speaking from the headquarters window, announced that a great victory had been won by the people and a powerful cheer of elation went up, Feeling the intense class hatred for the fascists and fearing for his own head, the police chief had remarked, "There was a wave of emotionalism in the crowd," The masses chanted "FOWER TO THE FEOFLE!" The Fanthers yowed not to leave the pro-The masses chanted "FOWER TO THE PEOFLE!" The Fanthers vowed not to leave the project no matter what tricks or attacks the fascists attempt. (During the three weeks before the attack, the authorities had attempted to confuse people by saying that the KCCF could stay if it did so "legally". This lie was exposed when the KCCF offered to pay rent and was turned down.)

The fascists withdrew under the pretext to allow the NCCF 24 hours to go to court to attempt to get a restraining order to prevent their ning order to prevent their eviction. Knowing well that the courts are only another fascist arm of the U.S. monopoly capitalists, the Panther members and supporters maintained their arms and prepared for further defense of their fundamental demo-cratic right to organize po litically to overthrow fas-cist Nixon and his masters. layed.

Meanwhile several resid

Meanwhile several residents of the project brought suit against the fascist police who had thrown them out of their own apartments in order to use the apartments as vantage points to fire on the Panthers. But due to the militant spirit of the people, the fascist didn't dare fire a single shot. The only shot fired that day was fired at a police car a few blocks away.

Today it was announced that two heads of a federal OEO program for legal ser-

that two heads of a federal OEO program for legal ser-vices were fired because their New Orleans lawyers represented the NCCF in see-king injunctions against ar-rests, This clarified the two lines in the resistance

struggle and showed that the bourgeoiste, in its desperate campaign to consolidate fascism, can no longer rule by liberal methods. This program was set up for the sole purpose of diverting the working and oppressed people, the fascists are kicking it aside. This will teach the broad masses even more clearly that imperialism is not sensible in any way, that they must follow Chairman Mao's proletarian revolutionary line of "MAINTAINING INDEPENDENCE, KEEP-ING THE INITIATIVE IN OUR OWN EMPLOYS." It demonstrates conclusively the truth of Chairman Mao's thesis: "POLITICAL POWER GROWS OUT OF THE BARREL OF A GUN."



Transplanting rice together

L AST MARCH heavy rains filled the Wanjung River in the Chilbsin commune in Hunan province, threatening to flood the crops. Late one stormy night, there was a terrific roar and part of the dyke protecting the fields of the Han nationality Lungkun brigade collapsed.

Awakened by the noise, Pu Hsing-cheng, Party secretary of the Miao nationality Manchus brigade of the same commune, jumped to his feet. Realizing that the Han people were fighting the storm on the other side of the river, Pu promptly organized the Miao members of his brigade, Ignoring the intense storm, they battled throughout the night, repaired the dyke and straightened up the flattened wheat buried under the mud. "An angry nature is strong," one of them said," when the Miaos and the Hans are united in the spirit of the Ninth Party Congress, we are stronger."

The next morning, when the Han members of the Lungkun brigade came across the river worned and anxious, there stood their dyke repaired and reinforced and beyond it their precious fields of wheat. Deeply moved, they told their Miao brothers, "You are more concerned about others than about yourselves." They had good reason to be moved, for the Miaos and Hans had fought and feuded for generations and the path to genuine brotherhood had not been easy.

The Miaos lived on the west side of the Wanjung River, the Hans on the east. In the old society, Miao chiefs. Han landlords and officials maintained and expanded their reactionary rule and exploited the people by constantly stirring up trouble between the nationalities, splitting and dividing them. A victous feud began in which more than a hundred Miaos and Hans were killed or wounded. Blood stained the waters of the Wanjung River. The two nationalities broke contact completely. Piliboxes were built by the landlords and chiefs along the river and the people became divided into two different worlds.

With liberation came the guidance of Chairman Mao's wise policy on the country's nationalities. The two peoples on the Wanjung River overthrew their common enemies, the landlords, chiefs and officials, became masters of their own destiny and started out on the socialist read together.

THE MIAOS AND HANS

However, Liu Shao-chi pushed a counter-revolutionary revisionist line to sabotage national unity and a handful of class enemies never ceased to sow discord. Misunderstanding and resentment left over by history continued to make unity between the two nationalities difficult.

Then in April last year, the Party's Ninth Congress was convened. The spirit of the congress blew like a spring wind over the mountains and villages along the Wanjung River. Party members and the poor and lower-middle peasants of both brigades carefully atudied the documents of the congress and Chairman Mao's call wind to win still greater victories". Each brigade knew that following Chairman Mao's call meant to strengthen the unity between the Miaos and the Hans in their own commune.

In the Miao brigade, Pu Hsing-cheng came home late from a meeting. Nevertheless, he sat down and again studied Chairman Mao's call. Horrible memories of the old days came back to him. His father, a poor peasant, had been killed deep in the mountains by a chief of the Miaos. His body was not discovered for five days, when some Han brothers found it and carried it home. His mother, crushed with grief and left with heavy debts, struggled to bring him up. Chairman Mao saved them from this sea of suffering. He had grown up on Mao Tsetung Thought.

Pu Hsing-cheng grew more and more excited—Chairman Mao always points to the direction for advance. Suddenly he threw the door open and ran toward the Lungkun brigade of the Han brothers.

Meanwhile, Tien Ting-an, Lungkun's Party secretary, had also been pondering what Chairman Mao's call to unity meant for his IIan brigade. Unable to sit stil, he had started off to have a heartto-heart talk with his Miao brother, Pu Hsing-cheng. The two met on the way, sat down in the dark night and poured out their feelings to each other, completely unaware as the dawn approached.

The next day, Pu and Tien took the 30 Communist Party members of their two brigades to an old broken pillbox built between the two peoples before liberation. Each with a copy of Chairman Mao; quotations, kny studied his teachings on classes and class struggle. They spoke to each other of the sad history of their feuds. Old Ma Tien-hua, a 73-year-old Party member and now member of the county revolutionary committee, told how the landlords and chiefs, had used contradiction between nationalities to forment trouble between the Miaos and the Hans. He described how five of Chairman Mao's P.LA soldiers had given their lives in order to wipe out the enemy in the pilibox in 1950. This was living history, the history of class struggle, and as the members of the two brigades listened, their political consciousness grew. The spirit of unity took greater hold. And Party members pledged to Chairman Mao: "We will take the lead in building up unity and we will give all we have to consolidate and strengthen our people's power, the dictatorship of the proletariat."



One night not long after this, the key over the Wanjung River glowed with the light of bamboo torches as the members of both brigades made their way to a joint struggle meeting against class enemies who had made trouble between the two nationalities. The Hans of the Lungkun brigade brought such a criminal. So did the Misot of the Manchia brigade. As their crimes were exposed, both peoples saw not separate enemies, but the common class enemy. Fury was saw not separate enemies, but the common class enemy. Fury was channeled in the right direction and the generations-old knot of antagonism between the Miso and the Han was united. Applying Mao Testung Thought had united the people. Formerly the Wanjung River had been a barrier dividing them. Now they named it "Brotherhood River", wowing to keep their revolutionary unity and make it grow.

United now on the foundation of Mao Tsetung Thought, the two peoples went on with the socialist revolution and the building of a socialist countryside with the com-

The Miaos of the Manchia brigade planted their sweet potatoes early last spring to get a bigger crop—one way of carrying out Chairman Mao's strategic policy. "Be prepared against war, be prepared against natural disasters, and o everything for the people." But bad weather struck and destroyed the seedlings. The Hans of the Lungkun brigade said, "The difficulties" of our Miao brothers are our difficulties"—they selected their best seed potatoes from their own storage and sent them over to the Miaos.

The two nationalities along the Brother-hood River connected this with the need to bend nature to their will and thus produce more for the nation and the world revolution. They decided to extend the dam on the river and make it produce more electricity. "With self-reliance and hard work," they said, "we'll paint a new and beautiful picture along both sides of the Brotherhood River."

April was the high-water season, the toughest stage in building the dam. One day before dawn, the sky grew black, thunder and lightning came and the rain began to pour. Party member Lun Tsai-lin of the Miao nationality awoke and hurried to the dam. In the light of his hurricane lamp he saw that part of it had already been washpart of it had already been washpart of the shouled for help and more than a hundred Miao and dan builders who were working day and night at the dam came running.

Chanting "Be resolute feet no.

Chanting "Be resolute, fear no sacrifice and surmount every difficulty to win victory", they carried stones to the break through the downpour. Pu Hsing-cheng and men from the Lungkun brigade struggled with a huge stone from the broken pillbox. But it was cumbersome and heavy, the road was slippery and they were about to fall in the swollen river. Tien Ting-an, a Han, and old Lung dynamite holes nearby. The tropest their tools and ran to help. Others from both brigades arrived. Ten young men formed a man-wall in the river to protect the stone-movers. Unity and a single aim scaled off the breach in the dyke.

With the same revolutionary daring and militant unity, the Miaos and Hans completed their dam ahead of schedule. On the day it was finished, several hundred sons and daughters of the Miao and Han nationalities dressed in their festival best and gathered on the bank of the Brotherhood Riverto sing and dance to the power of Mao Tsetung Thought. That evening, thousands of electric lights spatiked in the Miao and Han households in the mountains and a new song was created in the green bamboo forest:

Every light brightens our hearts
