THE TURNING POINT IN WWII

October 12, 1942

October 12, 1942

(Today, October 9, is the 18th anniversary of the Battle of Stalingrad, the turning point of World War II. On that day the heroic Soviet people, led by Comrade Stalin, turned the tide of battle and the German Nazis from that point onward were on the road to defeat and the worldwide front of anti-fascist people was on the road to victory. After the death of Comrade Stalin in 1953, the revisionist clique headed by Kruschov usurped power and restored capitalism in the Soviet Union, turning the world's first proletarian dictatorship into a dark fascist dictatorship of the bourgeoisie. Today, when U.S. imperialism and its chief accomplice, Soviet social-imperialism, have stepped into Hitler's shoes as the world's most rabid aggressors, the world's people are once again uniting to put an end to their common enemy. But the U.S. reactionaries have never been able to run roughshod over the world's people, and today they, too, are "ON THE VERGE OF EXTINCTION" conducting "A LAST DESPERATE STRUGGIE" while the revolutionary forces "ARE APPROACHING VICTORY." — Ed.)

The Battle of Stalingrad has been compared by the British and American press to the Battle of
Verdum, and the "Red Verdum" is now fanous all over the world. This comparison is not altogether
appropriate. The Battle of Stalingrad is different in nature from the Battle of Verdum in World
War I. But they have this in common—now, as then, many people are nizled by the German offensive
into thinking that German year still win the war. In 1916 the German forces launched several attacks on the French fortress of Verdum, two years before World War I ended in the winter of 1918.
The commander-in-chief at Verdum was the German Crown Prince and the forces thrown into the battle
were the cream of the German amy. The battle was of decisive significance. After the feroclous
German assaults failed, the entire German-Austrian-Turkish-Bulgarian bloc had no future, and first
then on its difficulties mounted, it was deserted by its followers, it disintegrated, and finally
collapsed. But at the time, the Anglo-American-French bloc did not grasp this situation, believing
that the German amy was still very powerful, and they were unware of their own approaching victory.
Historically, all reactionary forces on the verge of extinction invariably conduct a last desperate struggle against the revolutionary forces, and some revolutionaries are apric to be deluded for
a time by this phenomenon of outward strength but inner weakness, failing to grasp the essential
fact that the enemy is nearing extinction while they themselves are approaching victory. The rise
of the forces of fascism and the war of aggression they have been conducting for some years are precitally the expression of the last desperate struggle; and in this present war this attack on Dialingrad is the expression of which the world anti-fascist front

As a result of the homicidal ra-As a result of the homicidal ra-cial policy pursued by the reac tionary U.S. authorities, the population of the American Indi-ans has decreased from 1,000,000 to 600,000.

With the daily decline of U.S. imperial-ism, the reactionary U.S. ruling circles are intensifying op-

At present, the struggle of the minority nationalities in the United States has reached a completely new stage. Mexica American farm workers in the Mexicangrape plantations in California grape plantations in California have persevered in their strike for five years. On November 20, 1969, more than 150 American In-dians representing the 20 Indian tribes in the UNited States occu pied the Alcatraz island in San pled the Alcatraz island in San Francisco bay which used to be-long to them, and have remained there ever since. All this show an enormous rise in the politi-cal consciousness of the Ameri-can national minorities. Still more noteworthy is the fact that instead of confining their strugle to striving for freedom and human rights, they have directed its spearhead at the reactionary internal and external policies of U.S. imperialism. When Nixon Illumnathy ordered the district of U.S. imperialism. When Nixon flagrantly ordered the dispatch of troops to invade Cambodia to expand the war of aggression against Indo-China on April 30, they, like the broad masses of other American people, courage-ously plunged into a revolutionary mass movement against the Nixon administration's policy of aggression and war. voicing of aggression and war, voicing vigorous support for the just struggle of the three Indo-Chinese peoples. They have realized that the foreign policy pursued by U.S. imperialism i pursued by U.S. imperialism is a continuation of its domestic policy and that the reactionary system of capital-imperialism system of capital-imperialism is the root-cause of their hard-ship and poverty. Only by over-throwing the evil rule of U.S. monopoly capital can they achieve genuine emancipation.

INDIANS IN WASHINGTON STATE DEFY FISHING AUTHORITIES

Seattle, Oct. 1-- American Indians have once again shown their defiance of the fascist rules and regulations imposed on them by the monopoly ruling circles in an attempt to deny them their livelihood.

Showing open contempt for regulations making it illegal to fish outside of reservations, 20 Muckleshoot Indians took 10 King Salnon from the Green River yesterday, using gaff hooks and spears, which have been banned by state regulations. The Indians fished right under the noses of the fishery patrolmen, who could do nothing when faced with this should be for the first of the first of the fisher of detarmination. THOUSANDS OF PUERTO RICAN YOUTH SUCCESSFULLY DEFY IMPERIALIST DRAFT

New York, Oct. 4 — According to bourgeois press reports, thousands of Puerto Rican youths have defied the U.S. imperialist draft in protest of the genocidal policy of using youth from this oppressed colony as cannon fodder for the U.S. aggressive war against Viet Nam. Heads of Puerto Rican draft resistance Puerto Rican draft resistance groups and progressive organ-izations demanding independence from U.S. rule point out that when a Puerto Rican youth now files his intention to resist, he is usually given an immediate is usually given an immediace deferment. One youth wrote on his draft notice, "Go to hell and stop bothering me!" He received a h-F classification from the intimidated draft board

from the intinidated draft board in New York.

This policy is a frantic attempt by the U.S. imperialists to paper over the sharpening contradiction between the grow-ing national liberation struggle of the Puerto Rican people and the criminal colonial rule of

the U.S. imperialists. Since have mounted more and m powerful struggles for independence and national salvation and have often directed the cutting edge of their struggle against the draft for the U.S. wars of aggression in Indo-China. Recognizing this as a shameful attempt to set one colonial people against another, while the imperialists watch the fight, thousands of Puerto Rican youth have defied the U.S.

Rican youth have defied the U.S. selective service.
One such demonstration was held on Sept. 23, the 102nd amiversary of El Grito de Lares (The Outery of Lares), the day on which Puerto Rican patriots gloriously rose in armed struggle against the Spanish colonists and laid down their lives for their people. On this occasion, 1100 draft cards and induction notices were burned by a militant crowd of 20,000 of the revolutinary masses.

As the just struggle of the Puerto Rican people for national salvation develops, a People's War of great intensity will surely engulf the U.S. imperialists and wipe them off this lovely island once and for all The island once and for all. IRANIAN STUDENTS IN U.S. RISE IN ANTI-IMPERIALIST STRUGGLE

progressive Iranian students resident in the U.S. have recently held a series of militant demonstrations and rallies. Time
and again they have resisted the
attacks of the fascist U.S. police against their right to support the rising struggles of Iranian workers and peasants against the fascist monarchy of the

of six Iranian students. Fifty
people demonstrated their support for the six revolutionary
students who were attacked and

port for the six revolutionary port for the six revolutionary students who were attacked and arrested by the fascist New York police during a demonstration on Sept. 8 in front of the Iranian consulate. At that time the demonstrators were supporting the struggle of the Iranian people against the U.S. imperialistbacked Shah of Iran and his terrorist regime of national between rorist regime of national betrayal. While the demonstrators were chanting anti-imperialist and anti-Zionist slogans, members of the fascist Jewish "Defense" League and policemen arrived carrying Zionist signs and an Isra-League and policemen arrived carrying Zionist signs and an Israeli flag and attempted to provoke an incident. The Iranian students determinedly continued their chanting, clarifying that the Iranian Student Association condemms Zionism as a fascist ideology and movement but is not against the Jews as a people. Since their underhanded scheme had failed, the police then openly attacked the Iranians who fought back valiantly. Three police and three Iranians were injured and six students were arrested.

Addressing the rally in sup-port of the six arrested students an ISA spokesman pointed out that all anti-fascist and antiimperialist struggles around the world are united against the same enemy, U.S. imperialism and its lackeys. They closed down the Tehran Bazar and the universities and fought the Shah's troops with fought the Shah's troops with revolutionary violence. Thorsands have been arrested and tortured by the reactionary feu-dal government. Students, dem-onstrators and progressive religious leaders have been murdered glous leaders have been mardered outright. Iranian students ab-road have responded with resolute support for their people. On June 26, 41 Iranian students seized the Iranian consulate in Sanfrancisco to demand an end to political repression. They were met with brutal suppression by the U.S. authorities, arrested and imprisoned on trumped-up charges. Hundreds of Iranian students then demonstrated in support at consulates around

New York, Oct. 4 -- A rally was held at 2 p.m. today in front of the Queens House of Detention in Long Island City in support the courageous prisoners who

or the courageous prisoners who had risen up against fascist rules and regulations and seized and held the jail.

About 200 people enthusiastically supported the prison rebelion and applauded speakers from the Black Panther Party and the Young Lords Party. Progressive. Young Lords Party, progressive organizations of Blacks and Puerto Ricans, who called on the broad masses of the people to show their support for the prisoners' just struggles. Prisoners addressed the crowd with bullhorns from the occuwith outliners from the occu-pied jail. Numerous fascist police stood by nervously amidst militant shouts of "Power to the People!" and "Death to the Fascists!"

Because it was in the nature of a final offensive on which the fate of fascism hung, Hitler concentrated the greatest possible forces and even moved in part of his aircraft and tanks from the North African battle front. With the German attack on Kerch and Sevastopol In May this year, the war entered its third stage. Massing an army of over 1,500,000,which was supported by the bulk of his air and tank forces, Hitler launched an offensive of unprecedented fury on Stalingrad and the Caucasus. He endeavoured to capture these two objectives at great speed for the twofold purpose of citting the Volga and seizing Baku, intending subsequently to drive against Moscow to the north and break through to the Persian Gulf in the south; at the same time he directed the Japanese fascists to mass their troops in Manchuria in preparation for an attack on Siberia after the fall of Stalingrad. Hitler vainly hoped to weaken the Soviet Union to such an extent that, with the rear of both armies secure, the nain forces of the German army night be released from the Soviet theater of war for dealing with an Anglo-American attack on the western front and for seizing the resources of the Near East and effecting a junction with the Japanese, while the main forces of the Japanese army might be released from the north for moving west against China and south against Britain and the United States. That was how Hitler reckened on winning victory for the fascist camp. But how did things turn out in this stage? Hitler came up against the Soviet tactics which sealed his fate. The Soviet Union adopted the policy of first luring the enemy in deep and then putting up a stubborn resistance.
