Hawkins reported that in response to the Vorster regime's crackdown on Black activists and their supporters, protests have been called in a number of cities. NSCAR has issued a statement calling for nationwide actions and telegrams of protest to the South African ambassador. Picket lines, protest meetings, and other such actions against the repression provide an opportunity to reach out to many forces--including Africans working and studying in the U.S.--and to involve them in on-going educational activities around South Africa.
