1. Spring Fund Drive Evaluation

Williams initiated a discussion evaluating the spring fund drive. By May 18 (the deadline set by the convention), the national office had received \$18,436 of the \$22,000 goal. By June 3, \$22,074 had been received, 100 percent of the goal. The average pledges were \$24 per member, or 26 percent of the entire goal. At the end of the drive on May 18, the fund drive was 16 percent behind.
