"3. The Pranch agrees to abide by these fundamental princf les governing the working of the Hill and the FI as revolutionary organisations"

Mutton proposed to keep last phrase. Beafeted 3-6-2-0

Last porposed to recommend that branches vote on Button point separately from Manzano resolution . Defeated 1-8-0-1

Manzano resolution Carried unan. (This wote on content of Manzano resn).
