Dear Comrades,

The enclosed press release includes all information known at present.

Our press conference was covered by the national network television chains, as well as major New York newspapers. Judy White outlined the facts of the bombing, our view on it, and pointed out the damage. A reporter from the Worker attended.

We plan no special protest meetings. However, at forums and already scheduled meetings, an announcement of the facts should be made and Judy's statement, contained in the press release, should be quoted.

The next issue of the Militant will give full coverage to the incident. We need statements of solidarity from the branches, candidates, and prominent figures rushed in, by telegram if necessary, to be used in the next issue. Some messages should urge an even more determined New York election campaign against the war in Vietnam and unity of all antiwar groups in opposition to what can only be a terrorist campaign to intimidate socialists and other opponents of the war in Vietnam.
