All slogans of the March 26 demonstration will be used plus "Majority of Americans and Vietnamese want Americans out now". Demonstration in Berkeley was about 4,000. Considered a victory for the VDC. Demonstrations scheduled in Boston, Philadelphia and perhaps Chicago too. Parade Committee in New York also decided to put out a national release to all other groups to urge them to organize solidarity demonstrations in their cities.
