We the undersigned protest and oppose the exclusionary policy adopted by the New York Working Committee of the Student Mobil-ization Committee to End the War in Vietnam.

While not necessarily agreeing with the political views of the Young Socialist Alliance, we feel that any attempt to exclude activists from the work of Student Mobilization because of their political views endangers the very existence of the antiwar movement.

- We therefore demand of the New York SMC Working Committee:

 1. That, in accordance with previous conference mandates, the Student Mobilization Committee hold a full national Conference in a central location in the midwest, June 29-30, so that the greatest number of student antiwar activists will be able to discuss, formulate, and vote on the future of SMC and its actions and projects, as well as elect national officers and staff who will carry out conference decisions.
 - 2. That, as a concrete affirmation of the policy of nonexclusion, Kipp Dawson and Syd Stapleton be returned to the staff of Student Mobilization.
