#### To All Organizers and At-Largers

Dear Comrades,

At the Thanksgiving Convention of the YSA we projected a circulation of 10,000 for the Young Socialist by the summer. This decision reflects the importance of reaching increasing numbers of students and young radicals with our press.

To help reach this goal, the National Executive Committee has decided to launch a ten week spring subscription drive from March 15 through May 31, to obtain 1500 new subscriptions. The proposed quotas for the locals are listed on the enclosed chart. At-largers have not been given quotas, but we encourage them to agree to sell at least three subs during the subscription drive.

Unlike the fall YSA-SWP sub drive, the spring campaign will be carried out by the YSA locals and at-largers alone. We will, however, offer a \$1.00 introductory subscription of 2 months of the Militant and 4 issues of the YS. This combination sub is easy to sell and will help boost the circulation of both the Militant and the YS. The regular \$2.00 one-year sub to the YS will, of course, be counted in the quotas as well. The quotas for the locals are substantially lower than those for the fall campaign. Comrades should have no trouble fulfilling the proposed quotas within the context of regular YSA activities.

Locals and at-largers should follow the previous procedure of sending the sub blanks directly to the Militant at 873 Broadway, NY,NY 10003. They will then be forwarded to the YS for processing. Be sure to mark your local or area on the sub blanks so you will receive credit for all the ones you turn in.

On the attached sheet are acceptance forms for the proposed quotas. Each organizer and at-large member should fill out the form and return it no later than March 8. If we do not receive the form back by March 8, we will assume the quota has been accepted. Locals should assign a sub director to be in charge of organizing the campaign and forward the name to the N.O.

The new combination sub blanks will be mailed to you shortly.
