Here is a copy of the Communist Tendency statement that was read at the branch meeting September 7. The business portion of the meeting was through and I had just finished giving a summary of the Political and Organizational points from the convention. Neal Grover presented the statement. He is a rank-and-file member of the CT. He was neither the delegate nor the alternate delegate chosen by the CT to represent them at the convention.

No one attempted to prevent Comrade Neal from completing his remarks on the branch floor. After the first few sentences, it was clear to me that his remarks were out of order and a violation of discipline insofar as they re-open questions which were decided by the convention. I raised no objection because I thought we were hearing a statement of resignation by the CT. At the conclusion of the statement, when it was clear that this was not the case and Comrade Neal asked that this statement be appended to the minutes, I took the floor and indicated that in my opinion it was only necessary for comrades to loyally abide by the decisions of the party in a disciplined and centralized fashion to remain in the party. Furthermore, I stated that I thought that we had just heard a declaration of war on the party. I then moved to table the question to the **executive** committee, promising that we would have, "something to say on the question" at the next party meeting.

## STATEMENT OF THE COMMUNIST TENDENCY

On August 15 Richard Nixon announced a wage-price freeze. The crisis of capitalism has reached an acute stage in the development of its own "death ageny".
