Dear Comrades,

We sent you today by air mail 20 copies of the first issue of the English edition of INPRECOR. As you will see the subscription rate for the USA is US \$ 7.50 (normal) and US \$ 16 (air mail). We have inquired about the air freight rate for the United States: in order to send air freight, we must sent a minimum of 250 copies, the cost is US \$ 40. If you consider ordering 250 copies of INPRECOR (you might want to sell the spanish edition as well in the spanish speaking community) we could charge you 30 cents per copy plus the air freight charge which amounts to 12 cents per copy, that is a total of 42 cents per copy, which leaves you a margin of benefit of 8 cents per copy.

Can you please let us know as soon as possible how many copies you want us to send you.

Dear Anna,

We received your letter of May 15 three weeks ago, but the bundle of twenty copies of the first issue didn't arrive until today. The subscription rate is clear.

As I indicated in my letter of April 19, it is not the custom here for subscriptions to publications to be distributed from a central office. Individuals order their own subscriptions to be sent directly to their home addresses. Most comrades will probably buy their first few issues through the bookstores as samples of the publication before subscribing.

Please send a sample copy of the English, French and Spanish editions of Inprecor to each of the bookstores so that the comrades there can see the publication and make a decision about placing an order. I think you're right in thinking that several branches may want a few in Spanish and maybe even French. I have underlined the addresses of the branch bookstores on the enclosed directory.

The various branch bookstores will decide what size bundles is realistic for sale in their bookstores. Whatever size bundles each bookstore orders should be sent directly to the bookstore, and all financial responsibilities and transactions must take place directly between the bookstores and Inprecor. This is also the case with the press of all the sections and Intercontinental Press.

You have indicated that for a bundle of 250 copies you would charge 30 cents per copy. I doubt that any branch will be able to order that large a bundle, so they will need to know the cost per copy for smaller bundles.

We would like to receive an airmail exchange bundle of the following for each issue for use in our national office and editorial offices:

- 25 copies of the English edition
 - 5 copies of the French edition 5 copies of the Spanish edition
- Please send these to SWP National Office, 14 Charles Lane, New York, N.Y. 10014. In exchange we will send you however many copies you need of The Militant, International Socialist Review and Young Socialist.
