In 1972 twenty-five million young people in this country will be eligible to vote for the first time. Many of us are already active in political and social attraction.

Young Socialists for Jenness and Pulley are supporters of the Socialist Workers Party candidates -- Linda Jenness for President and Andrew Pulley for Vice-President. We believe that the 1972 Socialist Workers campaign offers the only meaningful alternative to the capitalist Democratic and Republic parties.

Unlike the Young Democrats and the Young Republicans, the Young Socialists are campaigning to build the independent mass movements, such as the antiwar movement, the women's liberation movement, and the Black and Chicano movements.

THE STUDENT MOVEMENT

We are taking the Jenness-Pulley campaign into the high schools. Our schools are run like prisons, with police in the hallways, overcrowded classrooms, and inadequate facilities. Billions are wasted on the war, while school funds are cut. Many of us are forced to end our education because of lack of money. Jenness and Pulley call for free education through the university level for everyone who wants it. Today, even with diplomas, many of us can't find jobs. We demand guaranteed jobs at union wages for all when they leave school.

High school students are demanding the rights of all other citizens. Jenness and Pulley are the only candidates who unconditionally support the rights of high school students to free speech, freedom of the press, and freedom to form political organizations in the schools.

Many students will be voters in 1972. They have the right to hear and discuss in school the ideas of all the candidates.

There are laws today which prevent people under 21 from signing contracts, working, travelling and living as they wish. Young people are also denied the right to a jury trial and to serve on juries. We demand an end to this discrimination.

Many students are being denied the right to vote and run for office where they live and go to school. We are for full voting rights for students, and against discriminatory age qualifications for candidates.

Today the schools are used to train young people to fit into an alienating, oppressive system. We believe that educational resources and facilities should be used to help build the movements for social change. Schools should become centers for organizing the antiwar movement, the women's liberation movement, and the struggles of oppressed nationalities. We are for Black and Chicano studies departments, run and controlled by Blacks and Chicanos. We are for women's studies departments, run and controlled by women. We are for student and faculty control of the schools

THE YOUNG SOCIALISTS FOR JENNESS AND PULLEY

Young Socialists for Jenness and Pulley are antiwar activists. We are helping to build and organize antiwar demonstrations calling for the immediate and unconditional withdrawal of all U.S. troops from Southeast Asia. We demand the abolition of ROTC, military recruiting and war research on campus. We demand an end to the draft.

Women are an oppressed majority of the population. A woman is denied the right to decide whether or not to have an abortion, has virtually no child care facilities available, works for 60% of the wages men earn, and is discriminated against in job opportunities and education. High school women are denied access to contraceptives and abortions, and then are expelled if they become pregnant.

Young Socialists for Jenness and Pulley are building the movement for repeal of all anti-abortion laws. Women are uniting on a national scale to build mass demonstrations and take other actions to win for women the right to control their own bodies—for an end to restrictions on abortions and contraceptives, and for an end to forced sterilization.

Many young socialists for Jenness and Pulley are activists in the national liberation struggles of African-Americans, Chicanos, Puerto Ricans, Asian Americans, and Native Americans. We call for Black, Chicano and Puerto Rican control of the Black, Chicano and Puerto Rican communities, including the schools. We demand that security guards and cops be removed from the schools. We call for open admissions to the universities for students from the oppressed nationalities.

INDEPENDENT POLITICAL ACTION

We can't demonstrate against the policies of the Democrats and Republicans one day, and vote for them the next. These parties are responsible for the war, and for the exploitation and oppression of workers, students, women, Blacks, Chicanos, gays and other oppressed people.

Chicano youth are in the forefront of the formation of La Raza Unida Parties. These parties can mobilize La Raza, independent of the capitalist parties, in the fight for liberation.

Jenness and Pulley call for the building of a mass, independent Black political party, based on the struggle for Black control of the Black community.

Only by independence from the capitalist parties can we deal effectively with such life and death problems as pollution. The capitalist politicians do nothing, while our environment is being destroyed by the big corporations. People who work for the corporations responsible for pollution, and those who live in the affected communities, should have the power to enforce pollution control. We demand a 100% tax on the profits of corporations that pollute.

The majority of the people in this country produce the wealth, but receive only a tiny share of what is produced. Working people are being forced to pay for the war in Indochina through higher taxes and inflation. Government wage controls are used to prevent workers from getting pay raises to compensate for the rising cost of living. Rising unemployment hits young workers the hardest, especially in the Black and Brown communities. We think the labor movement should end its subservience to the Democrats and Republicans and organize a labor party, based on the trade unions. Such a party would fight for the interests of all working people.

Young Socialists for Jenness and Pulley are part of the international revolutionary socialist youth movement. We are in solidarity with the Vietnamese, the Palestinians,

and all oppressed people of Asia, Africa, and Latin America. We defend the struggles of oppressed nationalities everywhere, such as the civil rights struggle in Northern Ireland and the nationalist movement for an independent, socialist Quebec. We support the worldwide struggles of youth from Paris to Warsaw, and from Tokyo to Mexico City.

This society has the wealth and technology to more than meet the needs of every single citizen. But this wealth is controlled by a tiny minority of capitalists who are only interested in profits. They are the ones responsible for the warped morals and sterile values in this decaying system.

Young Socialists for Jenness and Pulley are fighting to replace this system with a socialist society, where production and resources are controlled by the majority and serve their interests.

Some of us are members of the Socialist Workers Party and some are not. We all agree that the Jenness-Pulley campaign is the only alternative to the capitalist parties in this election.
