To the National Executive Committee:

We feel we have incorrectly called our document a draft resolution on antiwar work. It is actually a criticism of the NEC draft and our work in the past period. We are in agreement with the general line of the NEC draft and were at the time we wrote our document. We were incorrect to submit our serious criticisms in the form of a counterresolution. We do not believe our criticisms constitute a counterline. However we feel our criticisms are necessary to clarify and concretize the general line of the NEC draft.

We believe that discussion of our criticisms is so important that we intend to request the convention to give us equal time.

As of this date we have meceived no copies of our document or the NEC reply.

We request that copies of this letter be sent to the locals as quickly as possible.
