Dear Comrades,

At its meeting on July 12, the NEC voted to call a NC plenum for the weekend of September 8-10, 1967, in New York, with a tentative agenda as indicated in the minutes.

The National Mobilization Committee has not yet made a final decision concerning a conference to discuss electoral action, but it is tentatively scheduled for sometime during the Labor Day weekend in Chicago. The National Conference for New Politics has called its conference for August 31 - September 4, and the NMC conference is almost certain to take place about the same time. We will probably need a YSA mobilization for the NCNP and/or NMC conference. The NEC felt we could minimize financial and time burdens by holding the NC plenum the following weekend in New York, thus taking advantage of the presence of west coast NCers.

After considering the amount of material that has to be covered under each of the major reports on the agenda — the SWP '68 election campaign will be launched shortly before our plenum, and October 21 will be only six weeks away — the NEC felt that a two day plenum would be inadequate to allow for full discussion. The present proposal is to begin the plenum with a Friday evening session, continue through Saturday, and finish up Sunday afternoon.
