Dear Comrades,

The July-August issue of the Young Socialist will be a special 32-page issue in tribute to the Cuban revolution. It will include an interview with a young Cuban revolutionary and a picture spread showing how the revolution developed, etc. Also included will be an article on Vietnam veterans against the war and an exclusive eyewitness report from the International War Crimes Tribunal.

This issue should sell very well and we are doing some extra publicity on it, e.g., an ad in the convention issue of New Left Notes.

We encourage the locals to consider raising their bundle orders, keeping in mind that this is the only issue of the year that can be sold for a two-month period.

A change that we feel is necessary at this point is the elimination of the 3¢ profit that the locals make on each copy of the YS sold. The most a local can make now, for instance, on a bundle of 300 is \$9. With the extra cost of printing the YS on a monthly basis and the use of more pictures, it becomes necessary for the N.O. to make this change immediately, starting with the July-August issue. This means that the entire 15¢ selling price per copy will be paid to the National Office.

So we can get a feel for how sales are going, and so we can circulate ideas among the locals on good ways to sell, locals should send in a report sometime around the end of July.

As part of our continuing drive to build the circulation of the YS we will be making a special offer for the July-August issue with the aim of really stimulating sales. The local which sells the most YSs per capita will receive free of charge the total number of YSs sold. Locals should indicate any change in their bundle orders as soon as possible.
