Dear Comrades.

One of the regular features that we hope to include in the new YSA monthly publication is a "Socialist Directory." This directory, however, will be similar to the "where to find us" section of the YSA Convention Wall Poster.

As with the directory in the Wall Poster, we would like to include—in addition to the address of the local headquarters—as many campus addresses as possible. Such a format will enable students to contact the YSA easily on their own campus, and will project the YSA as a campus organization on scores of schools around the country.

We will be using the list in the Wall Poster as the basis of the new directory. But this initial list is far from complete; many areas did not send in a full list of all the campuses where they are active. Organizers should check the "where to find us" column to determine which schools have already been included from their areas. The campus YSA address for any school—whether high school or college—not on this list should be sent in to the National Office.

Where the YSA does not already have a campus box and telephone number, the address and phone number of a comrade on that campus can be used. In addition, if no address is available for the first issue of the newspaper, comrades should try and establish one for use in subsequent directory columns.

As the deadline for the October issue of the paper, is Monday, September 4, all information for the column must be received by that day. Therefore, this matter should be attended to promptly for additional campus addresses to be included in the first issue.
