INTRODUCTION

The following publications report indicates sales during the last four months—Sept 1967 thru Dec 1967. Overall sales figures indicate a continual growth. Since 1964, sales have increased over 5 times. Overall sales figures for 1967 are \$17,872 more than 1966. The biggest jump in 1967 sales has been to branches. The next largest is to bookstores and dealers.

Sales to foreign customers are up over \$5,000 over 1964 and \$2,674 over 1966. Largest sales to foreign countries include India, England, Ceylon, Australia and Canada.

Sales to individuals around the country have increased by \$3,913 since 1964 and \$1,657 since 1966. Sales to organizations increased \$4,713 since 1964 and \$2,061 since 1966. These organizations include Vietnam Committees, black student groups on various campuses, SNCC, etc.

The catalog has received a wide distribution with over 20,000 sent out in 1967. Requests for bulk catalogs have come in from various committees, student groups, etc.

The highest selling areas have been Berkeley, New York, Chicago, and San Francisco.

We have been receiving a lot of interesting orders lately. Several new Afro-American bookstores have opened around the country and are ordering large quantities of literature. One, in Dayton, Ohio, has ordered 3 times in the last month and a half. We have also received a number of orders from prisoners—these orders are usually for Afro-American material. A steady trickle of orders from servicemen has also begun. These orders are generally for pamphlets on the black struggle and on the war in Vietnam. Several campus groups have also begun to order in bulk. In Iowa, the Socialist Discussion Club orders in bulk for its classes. The E. Lansing SDS just sent in a check for \$110 worth of literature.
