

THE ORIGIN AND NATURE OF THE DIFFERENCES

The nature of our differences with the CPC falls roughly into three categories. The first is regarding the programmatic aspect, i.e., the class character of the present Indian state and government, the character and role of the different sections of the Indian bourgeoisie and its attitude to imperialism, etc. The second concerns with the actual assessment of the economic-political situation in the country, the degree of development of the class contradictions and class consciousness among the proletariat and toiling peasantry, and the concrete tactics and forms of struggle adopted to the requirement of the mass struggles. The third category is in the matter of political-organisational principles governing the fraternal relations between two Communist Parties, i.e., our Party and the CPC. We shall proceed to discuss the subject accordingly.
